Dubuque is an Iowa city on the Mississippi River. The National Mississippi River Museum and Aquarium explores life in and around the river. Northwest, the Dubuque Arboretum and Botanical Gardens include rose, herb and Japanese gardens. Mathias Ham House is a 19th-century mansion with opulent furnishings, with an 1833 log cabin on its grounds. South, the Mines of Spain State Recreation Area has trails and wildlife.

8:30 a.m. & 10:15 a.m. **National Mississippi River Museum & Aquarium** – Take a walk along the banks of the Mississippi River on Dubuque’s River Walk and admire the unique Dubuque cityscape. After a brief introduction, take a self-guided tour through National Mississippi River Museum & Aquarium, one of the state’s top tourism attractions. Enjoy award winning films, historic artifacts, and nine large aquarium featuring a Gulf of Mexico aquarium, an octopus, bayou alligators, playful otters, and giant catfish.

9:00 a.m. & 10:45 a.m. **Delight in Dubuque** – Take a narrated motor coach ride through downtown Dubuque which highlights the architecture and history of the oldest city in Iowa. View the Mathias Ham House, Shot Tower, Old Jail, and more, capturing the flavor of life along the Mississippi during the golden era of steam boating. Witness the Victorian mansions peppering the bluffs of this community, before traveling to Eagle Point Park with its breathtaking views of the Mississippi River Valley and Lock & Dam #11.
