**Annapolis, MD** is the capital city, on the Chesapeake Bay. Its historic district includes 18th-century brick houses and the domed 1700's Maryland State House. On Church Circle, the Romanesque-style St. Anne's Episcopal Church has Tiffany glass windows and a historic cemetery. Oysters, crabs, scallops, and all types of fresh fish were a big part of the coastal colonial diet and a thriving industry in Annapolis. Over 200 years later, the Bay's oysters and blue crabs still rank high on the list of favorite Annapolitan foods.
