Milwaukee is the largest city in the state of Wisconsin. Located on Lake Michigan, the second largest of the five Great Lakes with 22,300 square miles of fresh water. The Milwaukee River Walk spans nearly 3 miles along the Milwaukee River. There are 17 museums in downtown Milwaukee and 25 including the surrounding counties. Milwaukee is nicknamed Cream City because of its distinctive cream-colored brick, and Brew City, because of its rich brewing history. Milwaukee is the birth place of Harley-Davidson (1903) and home of the world's only Harley-Davidson Museum. The Rockwell Automation/Allen Bradley Clock tower houses the 2nd largest four-faced clock in the world. It's even larger than the famous Big Ben in London!
